#### St Osmund's Wristbands

Hopefully your child will tell you about our new school wristbands. The bands are in our school colours and are imprinted with our school Mission Statement, "Love for God, Love for Each Other, Love for Learning" - shortened to L4G ~ L4E ~ L4L. This is a visual reminder of what we are about at St Osmund's and is, essentially, our behaviour policy, owned and shared by all.

In class, the children will move up the class star chart each time they end the day on the 'Superstar'. If they reach 20, they will receive a special star to add to their wristband and wear with pride. It will be a permanent reminder to them of their achievements.

This is a reward for all children as everyone will receive a wristband – even the adults – and the children will earn stars for their consistently good behaviour.
