Reception Farm Visit

Reception Class visited Coombe Bissett Farm last week

Reception Class had tremendous fun last week when they visited Coombe Bissett Farm. They saw some new born lambs, and even got to hold one! They also saw some cows and learnt so much about how the Ewes look after their lambs; how the farmer gets up at 5:30am to go and check on her flock; the process of shearing and making wool into woolly jumpers and socks! Many thanks to Miss O'Gorman, Mrs Scott, Mrs Pyke, Miss Mitchell and Mrs Jonzak for organising and accompanying the children on the visit.

The visit was on a Farm owned by Wiltshire Wildlife Trust to educate young people about the workings of a farm as well as a longer term project to restore the fields to meadow – their natural state – lost to years of large-scale farming. The school are excited to be taking part in this project.

Collection at the end of the day

Parents' Forum


