## Year 5 trip to Beaulieu

Year 5 visited Beaulieu to begin their topic on the Victorian era.

Year 5 visited Beaulieu on Friday and enjoyed a tour round the Palace, the Motor Museum and the Victorian Classroom. They had an opportunity to dress-up and experience a little of what life would be like for a child their age living in the late 1800s. They learnt that by the age of 10, children were expected to get a job and on this visit, they were educated on two jobs in particular – a house maid, cook, or a chauffeur. Many thanks to Miss Dowding, Miss Hill, Mrs Odor and Mrs McKie for organising and accompanying the children on the visit.

The visit was part of the children's learning about the Victorian era. They will be learning through their History lessons, Art and English.

#### Collecting your child from school
