# **Remembrance Day**

This is the first in a regular series of safeguarding information only updates that I will provide in this newsletter. This first post highlights what safeguarding is, and who to go to if you have any concerns or questions.

It is my belief that there is nothing more important in a school than ensuring the safety and well-being of our children. At St Osmund's, I am the Designated Senior Leader for Safeguarding and Child Protection (DSL), and Mrs Sterck and Mrs Sambrook are the Deputy DSLs.

Safeguarding covers a wide range of areas including children's health, development as well as taking action to protect them from harm. It also covers aspects such as ensuring our buildings are safe; we have appropriate supervision of pupils; ensuring all our regular visitors and volunteers are DBS cleared and are aware of our Child Protection procedures.
