## **Attendance Matters**

Our rates of attendance are good and in-line with the national averages thanks to your ongoing support and the high importance you attach to schooling. The diagram below gives some further information on attendance.

Of course we encourage good attendance but as I have said before, we do not want children to come to school if they are genuinely poorly. We have been advised that with coughs and colds, children should come in to school; however with sickness and diarrhoea, children should stay at home for **48 hours after their last episode**.

#### **Reporting Absence**

Please ensure that you let us know straight away when your child is off school, ideally before 9am, by ringing us and speaking to the office or leaving a message. If we have not been notified, it is our school policy to ring parents on the first day of absence so if you can let us know, it saves a lot of time! If we do not receive a call or a message on the answerphone, and cannot contact you, the absence will be recorded as unauthorised.

To reassure you, the recent closure for the two snow days will not be recorded as an absence.
