Diocesan Inspection

As you are aware, last week we welcomed two inspectors from the Diocese of Clifton who were inspecting St Osmund's as a Catholic School. The purpose of a Catholic (called Section 48) Inspection is to ensure that the school is meeting its statutory obligations as a Catholic school, and to support the school in its evaluation of its Catholic Life, Religious Education and Prayer Life.

We cannot discuss the outcomes of the inspection at this stage but I would like to thank you all for your support and feedback during the inspection in the form of the parent questionnaire; it was wonderful to read what you feel makes us a special school – and a school that I am extremely proud to lead.
