Zero Waste Packed Lunch

This week we are challenging ourselves to reduce the waste from our snacks and packed lunches.

In Friday's assembly, I showed the children the waste collected from just a handful of packed lunches eaten that day. The waste included:

- Mineral water bottles
- Cling film
- Wrappers crisps, biscuits

This week we will weigh the waste from each class (divided by the number of children on packed lunches) and create a per-person figure. We will see on Friday which class has the least waste and which class has made the biggest improvements!

This about how you can reduce waste by:

- Buying biscuits/snacks in larger packets and putting them loose in the lunchbox rather than individually wrapped
- Using a refillable water bottle
- Avoid cling film and either put fruit/veg pieces loose in the box or use tin foil
