Today was Canon Michael's final Mass with us as Parish Priest. It was lovely to hear him talk about how much he has enjoyed serving as our Parish Priest and as our Leader in Faith over the last 12 years.

He spoke about today's Gospel which was the story of Martha, Mary and Jesus. In the Gospel, Martha was always so busy working hard, and Mary was always resting, praying and talking to God. Jesus asks us to be a little bit like Mary and a little bit like Martha – to balance the two.

In our Mission every day we can show our Love for God by talking to him in prayer, taking time to say sorry when we do wrong but also by working hard for the good of each other – which is us letting God live **through** us. If we can do this then our Love for Him, Each Other and our Learning will shine through.
