New Lunchtime Catering

You may be aware that Sodexo, our current catering provider will cease providing meals for St Osmund's at the end of this term. I am pleased to announce, however, that we have a new catering provider called 'Dolce' starting from the end of August. Particularly good news is that we are keeping our existing staff – Mrs Pearce and Mrs Archer!

Dolce offer an exciting menu with a wide range of choices and a very good system for ordering, paying and providing feedback. The testimonials from other schools that use Dolce are very positive so I am optimistic you will like what they offer.

School meals will remain at £2.30 but you must pay and order online – this will be much easier for you, us and the children but as you can imagine, it is a new way of doing things so there will be a meeting for all parents on Wednesday 17th July at 3:15pm. It is extremely important that you attend this short briefing on the new arrangements not only to hear about the new menu, but how the ordering and payments process will be handled.
