Times Tables

I am so pleased with the way the children have settled in to the new academic year; this week, the children have been well and truly in the swing of things with their learning. As a staff, we have been looking particularly closely at the children's learning in Maths – notably their grasp of their Times Tables.

While I am sure you notice lots of differences between what the children are learning in school now and what you and I learnt at school, something that has always remained central to confident learning in maths, are our Multiplication Tables. It comes in to just about everything and when the children know them it makes life much easier for them. By the end of Year 3, it is expected that ALL children will be able to answer questions from all tables (1x through to 12x) in a random order. E.g. 3x4, 7x8, 2x9 etc.

To support their learning, frequent practise at home is a big help - chanting, singing and random questioning in the car are all good strategies! Together, we can!

- Please do not use the school car park to dropoff/collect; it is private and for staff and visitors only (an exception is before 8:15am and after 4:00pm for Sunshine/after school clubs)
- Please do not park in the garage area outside our gates unless you own a garage
- Please do not park on the double yellow lines outside school, it impedes the ability to see approaching traffic and assess danger
- Please do not drive fast in or around our school
- **Pedestrians** please do not or allow your child to walk through the car park or walk through the vehicular gate but instead use the path and pedestrian gate. There are red and white barriers next to the path please do not go through these.
