#### Absence and lateness

For new parents (and a reminder to existing parents) if your child is ill or likely to be late, please remember the following:

- Telephone the school office and leave a message on the absence line, leaving your child's name, year and reason for absence – please do this for every day that they are absent (unless your child has vomited/had diarrhoea where the 48 hour rule applies – see below)
- If your child has vomited or had diarrhoea, they cannot come into school <u>48 hours</u> after the last episode
- If for any unforeseen circumstance you think you may be late, please inform the office by telephoning or leaving a message.

The school day for all children starts at 8:55am, where they line up in their classes. If you arrive after your child's line has gone in, please bring your child through the entrance by the office. The school day starts promptly after registration so a significant amount of learning is missed by children that are late.
