School Gateway

This is allows the school to send emails and texts to parents to keep them involved in school events. If for any reason you need to email the school, please use schoolcomms@st-osmunds.wilts.sch.uk

If your email needs a response we will endeavour to reply as soon as we can. This system is also used for you to pay online for clubs and school trips.

School Grid

This is Dolce (our new caterers) online system for you to pre-order and pre-pay school lunches. We operate the system in school but we do not handle any of the payments. We would prefer that you pre-order your child's lunch but they can do it in class up until 9.30am. If you pre-order lunches on this system and change your mind, you are able to cancel it/change it up until 9am on that morning.
