Safer Internet Day

On Tuesday next week we recognise Safer Internet Day. The way children play – and the interests children have nowadays – are very different from those that we used to enjoy. Children now spend an increasing amount of time on devices. I thought I would take this opportunity to share with you some information from a school advice service which is designed to be shared with parents, because while spending time on mobile phones, tablets, laptops, computers and game consoles can be positive and trouble-free, it can also put your child at risk.

These risks include online bullying; seeing sexual or violent photos, videos or other images; grooming (when someone builds a relationship with a child to exploit or abuse them), or simply not getting enough exercise.

UK doctors also say that children with excessive screen time tend to eat less healthily and show more signs of obesity; tend to have more depressive symptoms, and are likely to have worse educational outcomes, sleep and fitness levels. This may be because the screen time is replacing other activities, like exercise or sleeping. Face-to-face interaction also seems to be better for children's development. Whilst we appreciate some school work is set on computers, let's try to avoid other unnecessary screen time.

Head Lice

We have had a number of cases of head lice in school recently – across most year groups.

It is important to stop the spread of head lice and we cannot stress highly enough the importance of checking your child's hair and urgently dealing with any head lice or eggs. We have a child in school that has a bad reaction to head lice - in particular an allergic reaction to the saliva from the head lice when bitten. This has in the past meant hospital visits as the reaction has been severe enough to warrant this.

Please bear this in mind and we do ask that you check your child's hair TODAY and take the appropriate course of action. We have sent out an email with details on how to treat head lice. Many thanks for your co-operation and support with this.
