I would like to say another huge thank you to you all for your continued support of Online Learning at St Osmund's. The teachers and teaching assistants are working unbelievably hard to ensure that live lessons and independent work gives children the best possible chance of making progress during this second period of school closure. I am so proud of them, and of you all at home! Please contact us if we can help you get online; it is a legal requirement for children to be doing a minimum of 3 hours learning in KS1, and 4 in KS2.

To help you further, next week, we will be offering resource packs to all our families containing some basic but essential equipment to help with the independent learning at home. These pack will contain equipment such as: pencils, pens, ruler, rubber, whiteboard and pens, art sketchbook, a blank exercise book, cubes and counting resources (KS1).
