#### **Reporting an Absence**

If your child is going to be off school, for any reason and you inform their class teacher please don't assume the message will reach the office. May we politely remind you to contact the office either by telephone or email

### **Punctuality**

Please ensure that the start and end of day times are observed strictly. We really need children to arrive on time — not early, and not late. In the unlikely event that your child is early, they must wait on Carmelite Way until their start time.

This is vitally important as we seek to prevent contact across year groups (bubbles). If there is a positive case, and children are arriving late, it makes the job of identifying close contacts more complex.
