## Lockdown Easing

- Please continue to wear your face masks when on the school premises, including in the playground at drop off and pick up time.
- Please do not congregate in or around the playground, remember to keep to the social distancing ruling. When you have dropped off/collected your child, please vacate the grounds as soon as possible.
- The social distancing ruling of keeping 2 metres apart is still to be observed when you are in or around the school playground.
