Harvest

It is that time of year when we once again give thanks to God for all that we have, particularly when there are so many people across the world who are much less fortunate.

The Harvest season is traditionally the time when farmers would be harvesting their crops but specifically, would make loaves from the final wheat crop and offer them to the Church, who would then use the bread in the holy communion.

Nowadays, in school, we give thanks for the food we have – and the comforts that we enjoy – and do what we can to share that with others in our community who are less fortunate than ourselves.

Therefore, we ask that from Monday, and throughout next week, you send your child in with a donation, if you are able. The donation should be an item of food that is non-perishable, such as tinned vegetable, beans, soups, or packets like rice and noodles. We can also take donations of basic toiletries such as toothpaste and soaps. All these donations will be collected by your child's classteacher and packaged ready for our chosen charity, the Trussel Trust. The Trussel Trust are well-known locally for the work they do to support the poor and those in temporary need and they will use our donations in the food bank.
