Covid-19 Update

As you could probably tell from the quiet playground in the mornings last week, we had an increasing amount of pupil sickness which included a rising number of confirmed positive Covid-19. At one point we had over 30% of the school off for one reason or another, as well as, sadly, a significant staffing shortfall. We hope that all our children and staff who are off get well very soon. Not all schools are affected at the same time and last week, we seem to have had our surge in cases. Hopefully, it will settle down in the coming days. Thankfully, for the very large majority, Covid-19 remains very mild, particularly in children, and we wish all our community a sense of health and wellness this year.

Yesterday, the government sent out new operational guidance for schools and in it they are reflecting the news you may have heard recently that restrictions are easing in response to the national picture. Once cases at St Osmund's settle down soon, our intention is to move away, once again, from 'bubbles' and allow assemblies, singing and mixed playtimes again. While we need to ensure continued good hygiene and cleaning, the effect of such a prolonged period of isolation of classes has a noticeable and detrimental impact on children's social and emotional development. Children need to socialise, play with a range of other children and see each other as role models across year groups. We all miss our PSA events and at the recent meeting of enthusiastic parents, there was such excitement for the fundraising initiatives to come this spring and summer. Our intention is to return to normal as soon as possible – and we can't wait!

If a child is off poorly, but you believe they are able to do work, then they really should be in school.

Please do send your child in to school if at all possible. Attendance is very important and we are required to send all absence details to the Local Authority. Coughs and colds are normal at this time of year. Keep testing using LFD tests and isolate if positive for Covid-19.
