It is a common misconception that it is only the younger children that need to read with an adult. There are stages to reading development... fluency (the act of sounding out and reading words on the page) is just the beginning. It is as much about unpicking meaning, summarising content, expressing preferences, modelling expression and intonation... and more. As children move to KS2, they need to continue to read with an adult to support the development of all these crucial skills. When children move to independent reading too early, they risk developing a shallow understanding of what they read.

We can all develop as readers at any age 😂
